
1970 saw many changes in C. M. A. We were participating in a new athletic league, our daily class schedules were changed; in Junior School, girls were admitted.

for 1970.












DEDICATION


For the last nine years he has been of tremendous assistance to the staff, faculty, and cadets of this school.



Mr. C.M.A. is the model of what all cadets should be. He is what would make this school perfect were everyone like him. It is truly a great honor to be Mr. C.M.A.




